### Background

The Horizon 2020 MOCHA project identifies good child-centric approaches to primary healthcare. To adopt and implement innovative good practices across the Europe requires developing policies for different political and constitutional contexts. This explorative research aimed at identifying which concepts and insights of governance research are relevant when implementing child health policies.

### Methods

A literature review was conducted. The concept of 'governance for health' (Kickbusch/Gleicher 2012) was used to frame the search strategy and structure the findings. The findings of the study were integrated into a governance model.

### Results

The literature review revealed that no governance concepts exist specific to developing and implementing child health policy. Rather, general concepts of governance have to be embraced in such a way that child health policy making can be informed. Most promising concepts seem...
